<強調構文: not A but B の強調>

「…なのは、A ではなくB だ」という強調構文は、よく見る形です。しっかり学習しましょう。

(例文)

¶ It was not Tom but Jim that came to see me. ← 強調構文

= It was not Tom that came to see me, but Jim. ← 文末をさらに焦点化

= It was Jim that came to see me, not Tom. ← 文末をさらに焦点化:私に会いに来たのは、トムではなくてジムだった。

「私に会いに来たのはトムではなかった。ジムだった。」 「私に会いに来たのはジムだった。トムではなかった。」 などと訳しわけるとよいでしょう。 いずれにしても、not A but B の構造が文の前後に分裂しますので、気をつけましょう。
